

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN I PASS THE PRE-SWIM?

ONLINE

Once completing the pre-swim you will receive an email from Red Cross, you will have approximately a week to complete the online material. Which consists of training videos and reading material

IN PERSON/IN WATER

Once you have completed the pre-swim and the online portion you will receive an email from an aquatics manager where in the facility to meet and what materials to bring to class.

What does the pre-swim consist of?

"SWIM - TREAD-SWIM SEQUENCE"

150 yds. Freestyle or Breaststroke->2 minute tread no hands-> 50 yds. Freestyle or Breaststroke. (No Breaks)

Retrieving an object timed event Goggles are not permitted during the pre-swim.
